Grading Decisions: Spring Semester Grading Options

PC-19....earn a credit, generic "Pass", does not calculate into GPA.

Numerical average....earn a credit, grade calculates into gpa based on standard and weighted points for academic/honors/AP.

All grades posted on June 5 below 60 will convert to a **WC-19**.... No credit in course, but does not calculate into GPA.

Steps to making your decision

- 1. View your current average. Consult with each teacher now about options to improve your numerical average.
- 2. Research & explore post high school opportunities to determine how the numerical average or PC-19 may impact them.
- 3. Compare current gpa to potential of what gpa would be with numerical average.
- 4. Have a family discussion about how transparent you want to be about your academic outcomes.
- 5. Complete the required form and submit no later than June 12.

- Students must meet one of the following criteria but not both
- Minimum 2.5 weighted GPA
- SAT of 1010
- 19 on ACT
- Students still must submit a test score (Not test optional)


